

## *Graduation Attire*

---

- Ladies and Gentlemen **MAY NOT** switch cap and gowns.
- Only honor and AVID cords, honor society sashes, and medallions may be worn on graduation gown. \*Exceptions for academic and culturally-based stoles/cords must be pre-approved by Administrative Team by May 1st (see Mrs. Hood).
- Tassels are to be worn on the right side of the mortar board. Secure in place in the event of wind. **NO** decorating of mortar boards is permissible.
- Shoes are mandatory. Please do not wear high or spiked heel shoes on the field turf. Comfortable flat shoes are recommended.
- Dress appropriately for the weather. Business casual attire is recommended.

## Calendar of Events

The information listed below is to help you to know the important dates and times of upcoming events leading to graduation.

**Thursday, May 30th** - Seniors last full day of classes. Cap and gown distribution will take place at lunch on the *Little Theater* stage.

**Friday, May 31st** - Senior grades are due and transcripts are evaluated. Please make sure all work is turned in by 8:00am on May 31st.

**Sunday, June 2nd** - Baccalaureate (a non-denominational religious ceremony to celebrate seniors) is tentatively scheduled for 6:30pm in the LHS Auditorium.

**Baccalaureate is not a mandatory event for seniors to attend.**

**Tuesday, June 4th - Graduation Day**

**7:15am** - Senior Breakfast (New Gym)

**7:50am** - **Mandatory** Senior Meeting in the Auditorium, with graduation practice to immediately follow.

**If you do not attend practice, you will not be able to walk in the ceremony.**

**10:00am** - Grad Walk (following graduation practice). Seniors will walk halls of former schools.

**5:45pm** - Seniors are to arrive that evening to line up.

**6:30pm** - Ceremony Begins

## Graduation Tickets

Located inside your cap and gown bag, you will find 4 white and 2 blue graduation tickets. The use of these tickets is to ensure seating for the graduation ceremony for family members. The policy for use of these tickets is as follows:

- The high school stadium will be closed to the public on the day of graduation until 4:30pm. At that time, people possessing either a white or blue ticket may enter the stadium and secure a seat on either the grandstand or visitor side. Please check with your graduate to know what side they are walking in on. There can be no additional saving of seats with blankets, tape or signage.
- Please note that there is a full row of handicapped seating available on each side of the stadium. Additionally, there is wheel chair seating on the grandstand side. Each wheelchair individual may have one attendant with them for the ceremony.
- At 5:15pm the stadium is open to the general public. Please note: graduates are not limited to 6 individuals for graduation if held outside. The ceremony is open to the public.

In the event of bad weather, the event *may* be moved into the high school Old Gym. This will only occur if there is imminent danger to our graduates and visitors. If this occurs, **only the four white tickets may be used for entrance to the ceremony.** Overflow seating will be located in the auditorium with audio and video simulcast.

**Note:** For those family and friends who cannot travel to the high school for the ceremony, they may watch the festivities on-line by logging onto <https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/schools/lebanon-high-school-lebanon-or>. Please note you will need to create an account first but viewing is free.

## Additional Information

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** No spectators are allowed on the track or field prior to or during the ceremony. A professional photographer will be on the field taking both candid shots prior to the start of the ceremony as well as while each graduate receives their diploma. These pictures will be posted to the LHS website within one week after the ceremony for anyone to download and print. Family and friends are welcome to come down to the field at the conclusion of the ceremony to meet their graduate.

**DIPLOMAS:** Diplomas are not handed out during the actual ceremony, but need to be picked up at the concession stand immediately following the completion of the festivities.

**SENIOR FINES:** All fines/fees must be paid prior to the distribution of cap and gowns and/or the receiving of their diploma if not walking in the ceremony. Please contact the LHS Finance Office at extension 1027 if you have any questions about money owed to the high school.

**GRADES:** Senior transcripts will be reviewed prior to the morning of June 4th. Any student who has not met credit requirements, Essential Skills, Community Service, CRLS, Plan and Profile as well as turning in the Extended Application will be removed from the graduation line-up.
